- 1 The salary schedule provides an estimate of salary that can be earned during a full school year. For 2007-08, employees starting after 8/24/07 will have their salary adjusted to reflect the number of days worked during the school calendar year. Additional salary adjustments may include (but are not limited to): retention incentives, sick leave payments, additional payments, e.g., professional development stipends, coaching stipends, LEAP tutoring, PIP recurring payments, etc.
  
- 2 Teachers are categorized as 9-month employees. As such, during the 2007-08 school year, they are expected to work 190 seven-hour days with a 30-minute lunch. The annual salary quoted is paid to employees via bi-weekly paychecks over a 12-month period.
  
- 3 For the 2007-08 school year, teacher stipend pay is based on a rate of \$25/hour.
